The Boy's and Girl's 2009 Orange County Track & Field Championships is scheduled for Saturday April 25<sup>th</sup> at Mission Viejo High School, with both Mission Viejo and Esperanza High Schools to coordinate as hosts.

This will be the only mail out for this meet; all entries will be accomplished by logging on to [www.EPIsports.com](http://www.EPIsports.com). Complete meet information may also be obtained on the Internet at [www.octrackchampionships.com](http://www.octrackchampionships.com). The attached information card must be returned if you are planning to attend this meet and will serve as a contract. You may start entering your athletes on Sun. March 22nd, with all entries being closed by 10 a.m. Friday April 17th. Once all entries have been accepted or rejected, a performance list will be posted by Monday, April 20th on [www.dyestatcal.com](http://www.dyestatcal.com) and [www.octrackchampionships.com](http://www.octrackchampionships.com). Coaches will receive a declaration sheet of their accepted athletes and correct entry fees. It is imperative that all coaches report their best dual and invitational results to dyestatcal.com, episports.com, and the OC Register. The top reported fully automatic times (FAT) will have priority over hand times in the Varsity lane races. Upon completion of the Meet, results will be posted on [www.dyestatcal.com](http://www.dyestatcal.com) and [www.octrackchampionships.com](http://www.octrackchampionships.com). **\*\*Below I have noted an important change in the jumping events.**

Jumping event athletes are to report for check in with the jumping official when their event is called. Coaches and athletes' must be aware that all event times are approximate and events may finish prior to their approximate times. If an athlete needs to leave a jumping event to compete in a running event, they must first checkout with their field official, and then upon the athletes return to the jumping event the athlete will be inserted into the current jumping flight. Athletes may also select to jump prior to their assigned flight. If an athlete returns to the jumping event after it has been completed the event will NOT be reopened.

Coaches are responsible for reading all instructions for this meet and passing the information onto their assistant coaches and athletes.

There cannot be any Sport drinks, Soda, Gum, Sunflower Seeds, etc. on the artificial infield.
