**** Coaches please read the following information.**

- TIME:** Running events start at 8:30 a.m., and field events at 9:00 a.m. Gates will open at 7:00 a.m.
- FACILITIES:** Nine-lane 400m polyurethane track and runways. Athletes must wear **3/16" needle point** spikes. We will sell spikes at the meet. The concession stands will be open.
- AWARDS:** Orange County Championship awards will be given to the top **8** performers in all events on both varsity and frosh/soph levels. Varsity Athlete of the Meet awards will go to the overall top distance, field and sprint athletes. A perpetual championship trophy will stay with the winning varsity team for one year. Team awards will go to first place and runner-up in the varsity and only first place in the frosh/soph. In case of a tie, the points will be split equally and all athletes will receive an award. Coaches are to stay off the field unless requested to be there by meet management. Coaches may use the Coaches Corner, located near the athletes entry gate to the track to communicate with meet management at the finish line. Coaches may request their awards from the Coaches Corner as they leave the meet.
- ENTRIES:** Coaches must log onto www.EPISports.com to enter their athletes. Include a FAX number and e-mail where you can receive your confirmation sheets. Each school will be allowed **TWO** entries for each event and marks must be **2009** and **not** best all time marks. There will be no qualifying standards for entries. We will run only a set number of races, and accept a set number of field athletes, both are stated on the time schedule. See field events for starting heights and measurable marks. **Coaches may start entering their athletes on Sun. March 22nd. Entries will closed by 10 A.M. on Sun. morning April 17th. Varsity athletes with FAT reported to Episports.com and OC Register will have a priority over hand times for the fastest lane races.**
- ATHLETE REPLACEMENT:** An athlete, who is a "no show" due to illness or injury may be replaced with another athlete from the same school. Adds are treated as new entries and coaches must pay \$10.00 per individual event and \$40.00 (relay) for an add card at the athlete's & coaches check-in, for space available. Add cards are presented at the Clerk of the Course for entry into a running event, or a Field Official for a field event. Schools and Coaches will not be given credit when applying for an add card. **Each school will be limited to 4 adds for the boys and 4 for the girls.**
- ENTRY FEE:** The fee is \$10.00 per event, and \$40.00 per relay team. **Fees are to be paid once the declaration sheets have be returned by fax or e-mail to confirm your entries.** Make all checks payable to: Esperanza Track Boosters, *c/o Al Britt*, 1830 N. Questions regarding entries or fees should be directed to Al Britt/Meet Director, at home 949-249-2045, at school 714-986-7540 Ext.13423 or e-mail abritt28@cox.net. **A personal check will be required if you are unable to obtain a school check by April 25th.** We will hold all personal checks for a period of two weeks.
- FIELD EVENTS:** A total of 3 efforts for the F/S Long Jump & Triple Jump and 4 efforts in the Varsity. Shot Put & Discus will get 3 efforts in prelims and the Top 9 will get 3 additional efforts. Shot Puts will be provided for the competition, and Discus will be weighed. **Jumping event athletes are to report for check in with the jumping official when their event is called. Coaches and athletes' must be aware that all event times are approximate and events may finish prior to their approximate times. If an athlete needs to leave a jumping event to compete in a running event, they must first checkout with their field official, and then upon the athletes return to the jumping event the athlete will be inserted into the current jumping flight. Athletes may also select to jump prior to their assigned flight. If an athlete returns to the jumping event after it has been completed the event will NOT be reopened.**

Girls High Jump: Varsity 4'8" Frosh/Soph 4'6"
Boys Pole Vault: Varsity 12'0" Frosh/Soph 11'6"
Girls Pole Vault: Varsity 9'0" Frosh/Soph 8'0"

* competition to be conducted in continuous flights.

MEASURABLE MARKS: Boys Long Jump: Varsity 19'0" Frosh/Soph 18'0"
Girls Long Jump: Varsity 15'0" Frosh/Soph 14'0"
Boys Triple Jump: Varsity 39'0" Frosh/Soph 37'0"
Girls Triple Jump: Varsity 31'0" Frosh/Soph 29'0"
Boys Shot Put: Varsity 46'0" Frosh/Soph 44'0"
Girls Shot Put: Varsity 30'0" Frosh/Soph 28'0"
Boys Discus: Varsity 140'0" Frosh/Soph 120'0"
Girls Discus: Varsity 100'0" Frosh/Soph 80'0"

TIMING: Finish lynx timing system will be used in selecting the top 8 places in each running event. If there is a malfunction of the timing system the games committee reserves the right to rerun any race where an accurate time/picture is required for placing. Races may be recalled if the system does not activate.

CLERK OF COURSE: All runners must check in with the Clerk 15 minutes prior to their event. **Athletes who do not check in will be disqualified.** The CLERK OF THE COURSE will be located on the warm up area across from the North West end of the track. **Relay teams may check in with only one athlete; however it is the responsibility of the coach and relay athletes to be on the track for the correct race and compete in the assigned lane.** If an athlete or relay team runs in the wrong race or lane they will be disqualified. ****ATHLETES WHO ARE NOT COMPETING ARE TO STAY OFF THE INFIELD AND COMPETITION AREA DURING THE MEET!**

TRAINER: We will have a trainer available for injured athletes only. Each school is asked to supply their own tape.

SEATING: A few canopies will be allowed on the press box side at the top of the South seating section only, the remainder of the canopies must be at the top on the West bleachers or in the warm-up area. Parents and spectators are to sit at the finish line on the East bleachers.

T-SHIRTS: T-shirts will be on sale for \$14.00.

ADMISSIONS Adults-\$6.00; Students-W/O ASB card \$4.00; W/ ASB card \$3.00; under 10-\$1.00
CIF Cards will be honored.

*PARKING: Please look at the attached diagram for parking. Parents and spectators may park in the Mission Viejo parking lot. Buses will park in the far upper Southern parking lot. If this lot is filled then Buses may park at La Paz Jr. High School. Bus drivers will receive a map as they arrive at the meet.

SPECIAL NOTE: Athletes bringing radios, tape decks, soccer balls, and footballs will not be allowed at the meet. Athletes attending this meet must be under the supervision of a coaching staff member. (State and Southern Section Rule 307).
